RULES AND REGULATIONS
PLEASE NOTE – VERY IMPORTANT

1. Entries: NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY PAYMENT IN FULL FOR ENTRY FEES. AN OPEN CHECK IS ACCEPTABLE FOR PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES (NOT FOR PAYMENT OF STALLS – SEE ITEM 2 BELOW)

2. Stalls STALLS - \$100. MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MAKE FINAL ASSIGNMENTS CONSIDERING FIRST, THE POSTMARK OF THE RESERVATION ACCOMPANIED BY FULL PAYMENT; NUMBER OF STALLS; YEARS OF PARTICIPATION AND FINANCIAL SUPPORT. NO STALLS WILL BE RESERVED UNTIL PAID, AND NO PHONE CALLS WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR STALL RESERVATIONS – NO EXCEPTIONS! STALLS MUST BE PAID FOR BY A SEPARATE CHECK. AN OPEN CHECK IS NOT ACCEPTABLE FOR STALL RESERVATIONS. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY A SEPARATE CHECK FOR STALLS. STALL FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE.

ADDITIONAL STABLING INFORMATION

Temporary Stabling Facilities need to be vacated by **2 P.M., Sunday June 19th**. If you find it necessary to stay over, Please notify Robert Debord, David Peel or Elizabeth Holmes in the Horse Show Office, and they will assist you with other arrangements.

3. TENT DAMAGE: Tents, including the valance, must not be damaged or altered in any manner, i.e. cut, punctured, rods or tie chains adjusted or removed, etc. Damages will be charged to the exhibitor occupying the damaged portion of the tent.

4. OFFICE FEE: \$15 per horse.
5. BEDDING: Shavings will be available for purchase directly from Show and may be ordered **in advance** on the entry form and returned along with your stall reservations and/or entries. Orders needed prior to Monday, June 13th, must be requested **NO LATER THAN 4 p.m., FRIDAY, JUNE 10th** by calling David Peel at (423) 902-3228. Beginning on Monday, June 13th, all orders must be in the show office prior to 10 am for same day delivery. **No First Bedding Furnished.**
6. PAYMENT: **Exhibitors wishing to pay their show account individually must complete a separate entry form to set up a separate account and furnish Social Security Number or Tax I.D Number.**
7. POST-ENTRY: Entries postmarked after May 16th, except those for stake and championship classes, will be considered post-entries and will be charged \$25 per horse in addition to the regular entry fee. Post entries will also be accepted during regular office hours.
8. REFUNDS: Entry fee refunds requested prior to the entry closing date (May 16th) will be made in full less the non-refundable office fee (per horse) of \$15. After the closing date, entry fees will be refunded only with a veterinarian's certificate. Exhibitors may enter other classes, but no entry fee will otherwise be refunded. **STALL FEES ARE NOT REFUNDABLE**
9. SCRATCHES Must be made in the show office by 9 A.M. for morning performances and during regular office hours for evening performances.
10. NOVICE RIDER **For purposes of this show, a novice rider is defined as a rider who has not won 3 blue ribbons in ANY under saddle classes, excluding blue ribbons won in one day competitions and academy classes.**

14. CLASSES: The show management reserves the right to
limit entries, change, cancel, or combine classes
at its discretion to compensate for excessive or
inadequate entries, without claim for damages.
**Qualifying classes will be split as follows:
Academy at 12, Ten and Under at 12, Driving
and junior exhibitor at 15, and all others at 25.
NO ADDITIONAL CLASSES WILL BE ADDED
TO THE SCHEDULE, BUT WE WELCOME
YOUR SUGGESTIONS FOR NEXT YEAR.**
15. REQUEST
FOR HOLDS: For the benefit of all exhibitors, please cooperate
as best as you can by submitting requests for
holds during established show hours. Any
unforeseen hold should be communicated to the
paddock master.
16. NEGATIVE
COGGINS: Must accompany each horse, current within
1 year of show. Proof will be required when
picking up back numbers. If possible, please
send a copy with entries to expedite office time.
17. DISCIPLINE: Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy
or disobedience to the judge, or officials, on
the part of the owner, manager, rider, driver,
or attendant shall be grounds to disqualify the
horse. The owner shall forfeit the entry fee
and other fees. In the case of any horse being
disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding
prize in that class shall take the prize that has
been awarded to such disqualified horse.

18. WARMUP & SHOWRING COURTESY: Exhibitors and trainers are cautioned as to their conduct in and around the show and warm-up rings, especially in respect to schooling of horses. Items such as **tape measures, blow horns, split bamboo poles, or whips longer than 6 feet** that would alter or disturb the performance of a horse are prohibited.
19. SHOW MANAGEMENT: Should any questions arise that are not provided for in the rules stated herein, the same shall be referred to the show management whose decision will be final. The show management reserves the right to decline to receive any entry and to return any entry fee and/or stable fee before or during the show, without being liable for compensation. Every class offered herein will be conducted in the spirit of USEF rules and judged in accordance therewith. The show management will act as steward when any rule needs to be reviewed for clarification. In the event of protest, the fee is \$100 payable to The Chattanooga-Cleveland Charity Horse Show, Inc. and is non-refundable.
20. LIABILITY: The Chattanooga-Cleveland Charity Horse Show, Inc., the Tri-State Exhibition Center, and Signal Centers, Inc. will not be responsible for any accident, theft, damage, or injury occurring at the facility.

WARNING

Under Tennessee law, an equine professional or sponsoring organization is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated Title 44, Chapter 20, Part 1.

21. All vehicles must be kept in designated areas.
22. All aisles and roadways around barns or tents must be kept open at all times.
23. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the horse show premises.
24. All dogs on the grounds must be on a leash and under control at all times.
25. No recreational vehicles or trailers will be allowed to hook up to electrical outlets in the stall areas.
26. Gas, electric, or propane heaters, propane tanks, and hot plates are prohibited in stall areas.

27. All electrical extension cords must be twelve (12) gauge, three (3) wire and prong negative type.
28. All manure and used shavings removed from the stalls or trailers must be placed in manure pit or specified areas.
29. Barn aisles and doorways must remain clear at all times; stall guards on each stall must be closed and latched when unattended. No tampering with or removing of stall doors.
30. No smoking in any building, restroom, or stable areas.
31. Exhibitors will assist in maintaining clean facilities and grounds by placing litter in trash receptacles.
32. No balloons, helium items, fireworks, or fire extinguishers are allowed on the premises.
33. **PRIZE MONEY:** Prize money will be mailed to the party of record within 30 days after the show's end. Any checks not cashed by September 1, 2011, will be forfeited to the show. Returned checks will be assessed \$25 for each re-deposit and \$50 if a check cannot be presented to a bank as a cash item.

To be shown with a full mane and tail at an animated walk or flat walk, park trot, and canter.
